Premier cool to two ferry proposals.

Wednesday, November 17th 2010



Premier Darrell Dexter says the government has received two proposals aimed at bringing back a ferry service to Yarmouth.

Dexter says he has seen one of the proposals but stressed that neither are close to being considered for provincial funding help at this point.

He says both proposals, which he termed as nothing more than broad proposals, would require "a lot of work" before public funding is considered.

The premier also said there will be no operating subsidy provided if the provincial government offers help for a new ferry out of Yarmouth.

He says his position has always been that the government would consider short-term funding for any service that is shown to be viable over the long-term.

The province has consistently refused to subsidize a ferry service since pulling its annual subsidy for the high-speed CAT ferry last December.
